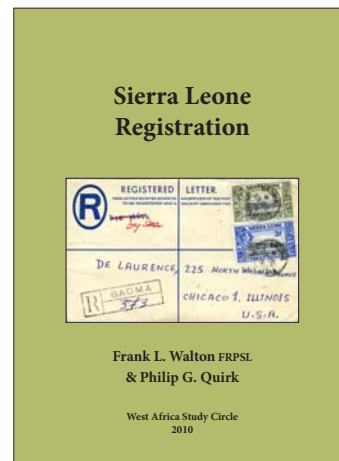
The first edition of this book was published by WASC in 1994. Since that date much new material has come to light; some of this has been recorded in Cameo, the journal of the West Africa Study Circle, but even more information has not previously been published.

This 48-page book lists all registered stationery, registered datestamps, village rubber handstamps and blue registration labels. Earliest and latest dates of use are provided for each of these categories.

The book is in A4 format with a card cover. It is profusely illustrated with all types of datestamps and labels being shown, as well as no fewer than 100 village rubber handstamps. The first edition only illustrated 55 of the rubbers; this demonstrates the considerable expansion of our knowledge since 1994.

Information is provided for both pre- and post-independence.
