

Issued in 1965–66 and printed by Harrison & Sons Ltd., London, and Delrieu of France, all these denominations are now in the gradual process of being re-printed at the Nigerian Security Printing & Minting Co. Ltd., Lagos in the original design and format but in sheets of 60 (sixty) each.

Supplies of stamps in the original printings could be made subject to the availability of the stock.
